

We come together to raise awareness and collectively raise money during the 2023/24 academic year.


#### **Charitable Fundraising Missions**


### RSHE

The deadline for Year 7 admissions is 31st October 2023. If you are considering a Year 7 place at Bishop Walsh Catholic School for September 2024, please ensure that you send a copy of your faith evidence (which is a baptism certificate or receivership into the catholic church) and the Supplementary Information Form (SIF). The template is available on the schools website under admissions policy 2024- 2025.
