This document contains detailed information about the requirements for uniform and equipment for Year 7 in September 2024 at Bishop Walsh Catholic School



Uniform

Uniform List Year 7-11; 2023-2034

Please note that fashion trends cannot dictate a variance in the uniform code. If you are unsure about any aspect of the uniform code please check with school before purchasing. The Principal is the person who determines 'acceptable' uniform.

Blazer	Navy with the Bishop Walsh Logo and House Saint name.
Trousers	Full length black trousers that reach below the ankle. Formal and plain in style. Trousers should not be made from stretchy material or contain lycra.
Skirt	Only acceptable in one style; Navy 3" stitch down pleat. Knee length and not elasticated at the waist.
Shirt	White for all year groups.
Tie	Bishop Walsh clip on tie for all students.
Jumper	Optional, grey plain v neck with Bishop Walsh Logo. No other jumper or cardigan is permitted. Coats are the only acceptable outdoor clothing to be worn, no hoodies or sweatshirts are permitted.
Socks/ tights	Only black or navy socks are permitted. White socks are not allowed. Socks are only allowed to be worn with trousers. Plain black tights must be worn with skirts.
Shoes	Must be plain black with a black sole. Boots or high heeled shoes are not permitted Please see attached some examples of permitted and non-permitted footwear (this is not exhaustive). If you are unsure please contact school before purchasing.
Jewellery	Students are not permitted to wear any jewellery. No piercings are allowed. <u>Students will not be permitted to wear retainers or plasters over piercings.</u> A wrist watch is allowed.
Makeup	Makeup must not be worn in school. This includes nail varnish and semi-permanent makeup; eye brow/ lash tint or false eye lashes. Acrylic and gel nails are not allowed for health and safety reasons.
Haircuts	Haircuts should be sensible; there should be no extreme haircuts and no extreme colour. Scarfs/head bands/clips should be plain black or navy.

Bishop Walsh Catholic School Equipment List

All pupils must arrive to school fully equipped and ready to learn. The list below outlines minimum expectations of equipment for pupils. Pupils must show their equipment to their form tutor in the line-up each morning. Pupils will be sanctioned for lack of equipment in line with the school's behaviour policy.

Every pupil must have;
