

# Year 12 and 13 Revision Opportunities

## Art and Design

In Art students can use the facilities in Art on Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays after school. From 3.30-4.30 on Mondays and Wednesdays and until 4.15 on Thursdays.

## Biology

At this stage in the year a top tip is get help from any biology teacher if you're stuck ASAP and complete all past papers on KEYS multiple times. There will be F211 and F212 revision after 8th May as part of the collapsed timetable- dates and times to be confirmed. Year 13 will be revising in lesson time shortly from now.

Year 12 F211 and F212 revision sessions will be on a Wednesday after school from 3.20 -4.20 until the end of this half term.

There is also an opportunity for year 12 to resit coursework after school during the week beginning the 27th April and for year 13 to resit coursework after school during the week beginning the 20th April.

## BTEC L3 Applied Science

Most of the students do have a revision guide for each unit that they purchased through us in the first term, however, if parents are looking to buy any for them, the AQA study guides and CGP ones are quite popular.

For Year 13s

They were issued with a pack of CHEM4 papers earlier in the term and CHEM5 papers before the Easter holiday to work through and mark using mark schemes online, which they are familiar with by now. They can also bring a memory stick in for all past papers and mark schemes.

They will also be issued with past papers and mark schemes in lessons, as we revise.

Health and Social Care

History

Mr Koryl is also running a revision session on Wednesdays after school for the British experience of warfare unit.

Mathematics

Year 12 and 13 have been given plenty of exam papers, along with worked solutions to these, written by a member of staff. These are also available on KEYS.

It is vital that students dedicate a lot of time to doing these papers, marking them and trying to correct any errors or questions that they were unable to complete. They then need to bring any problems into school

and ask their teachers for help with these questions. This could be done by highlighting problem questions, or by writing a list of questions to ask. Students are encouraged to ask for help during lessons and will be given opportunities to do this, but also to seek help from their teachers at other times such as lunch, after school or during their free periods.

We will organise revision sessions during study leave on the days prior to the actual exams so that students can ask any last minute questions they may have.

It is a realistic expectation that students should have done every past paper available at least once before they do the final examination. Students have also been given a record sheet for each module to keep track of which papers they have done and the marks that they get on the papers.

### Media

All sessions take place in Media Studies 2 and there will be past papers and revision materials available.

### Music
