

UNIFORM 2018 - 2019

Years 7 – 11 should dress within the following guidelines:

Please note that fashion trends cannot dictate a variance in the uniform code. If you are unsure about any aspect of the uniform code please check with school before purchasing. The Head of School is the person who determines what is acceptable or considered extreme.

TROUSERS Plain tailored black or dark grey trousers, full length to the shoe, not tight fitting and not containing lycra.

Only black socks should be worn with trousers.

SKIRT: Tailored plain navy skirt stitched down with 3" pleat and waistband to knee length (**not the old elasticated waist one**).

Plain black or navy tights. No Patterned tights, no socks with skirt

TIE School tie for all pupils.

SHIRT White or grey in Years 7 – 9 then optional light blue in Year 10 and Year 11.

JUMPER Grey v neck jumper for all pupils of all year groups (optional).

SHOES Plain black – business like with a low heel, no high heels or boots, no gold or silver embellishments, or additional colours.

BLAZER Navy with school badge and house group.

Make-up, nail varnish and tanning products are not allowed and pupils will be told to remove them. Acrylic or gel nails are not allowed for health and safety reasons.

Jewellery is not allowed, except for a wrist watch, and pupils will be told to remove it. This could lead to confiscation. Body piercing is not allowed.

Haircuts should be sensible, there should be no extreme haircuts or colour.

Scarves and outside coats must not be worn in the building.

Trainers may only be worn during PE lessons and not in class, break times or to and from school.

Year 7 have a new dance kit which can only be purchased from Gogna uniform suppliers this academic year. Other year groups may wish to purchase the new dance kit but this is optional.
